ITINERARY

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with Rochester Trolley & Tours. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

DAY1 Enjoy a leisurely ride through the flat lands of Minnesota and South Dakota as we make our way to the **Black Hills** area. Enjoy lunch on your own en-route with rest stops along the way to **Rapid City**. Once you have checked into your hotel we will head out for a relaxing dinner at a local restaurant which is included in your package. An early night's sleep is a must as tomorrow we will be starting at the crack of dawn!

DAY2 The annual **Custer State Park Buffalo RoundUp** occurs the last Friday of September each year. Approximately **1300 buffalo** are gathered up from the 71,000 acre park and driven by horseback and truck into corrals, where each animal is individually vaccinated and new calves are branded.

The buffalo are then sorted to determine which animals will be sold at the annual buffalo sale in November. The Custer State Park buffalo are highly sought after nationwide for their reputation as high quality disease-free herds.

6:00AM - After freshening up we will pick you up at the hotel and drive to the **Custer State Park RoundUp** grounds parking areas. We go to the south area of the park just above the corral where the rangers will work with the buffalo. The roads close early so they can start moving the buffalo over the hills without traffic being in the way.

8:00AM - We serve a hot breakfast of an egg-buffalo sausage-vegetable dish, muffins, fresh fruit, coffee, tea, hot chocolate and bottled water. We provide each guest with a bag chair to sit on as they eat and wait for the buffalo to come over the ridges.

10:00 - 11:00AM - After the buffalo come down and we watch the big stampede into the corral area, you can catch a shuttle to the corrals around noon to receive your included lunch of BBQ sandwich, chips, beans and a drink. Once you finish lunch you can walk over to the corrals to watch the rangers work with the buffalo.


3:00PM - Drive back to your hotel where you can freshen up, then we will head out for dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY3 After breakfast at the hotel, we will begin our travel homeward with fond memories made from that fabulous day at the Buffalo RoundUp and the scenic landscapes that South Dakota has given us to remember.
