4:00pm - Continue to Door Peninsula Winery to enjoy the tastes of exquisite door county wines!
5:00pm - Continue to The Lodge at Leathem Smith to check in for the night.
7:30pm - Dinner at the hotel is included.



- 10/5 **8:15am** - Meet your guide at the hotel for your first full day of fun in exploring some of the treasures that Door County has to offer, visiting the Lake Michigan side w/**Baileys Harbor** and **Cana Island** for a wagon ride over the Cosway to the island where you can explore this tiny island and go up in the lighthouse.
