ITINERARY

DAY 1

Climb aboard the spacious motor coach and get to know your fellow passengers on the way to the Windy City, Chicago, IL. There you will enjoy an **Architectural Cruise on the Chicago River**. View Chicago's breathtaking skyline and over 40 of their landmarks, including the Tribune Tower, Wrigley Building, and Marina City. From there continue on to South Bend, IN where, after checking in to your lodgings for the night, dinner is on your own.

DAY 2

Following breakfast, check out and journey to Fremont, OH to visit the historic **Rutherford B. Hayes Presidential Library & Museum**. From there, depart to Pittsburgh, PA where, after checking in, you will enjoy a delicious dinner at the **Grand Concourse**.

DAY 3

After breakfast and check out, spend the morning visiting the **Flight 93 Memorial** which honors the victims of September 11, 2001. Upon your arrival in **Philadelphia**, the birthplace of the United States, you will enjoy dinner at a popular restaurant before checking in for your three-night stay.

DAY 4

Grab a bite to eat before meeting your local guide for a **3-hour historic tour of Philadelphia**, the nation's first capital and the most prominent of the early English colonies. Afterward, enjoy lunch on your own in the area.

Spend the afternoon viewing the immersive exhibits and priceless artifacts of the **Museum of the American Revolution** that trace the evolution of the colonies from the early days of civil unrest through the Revolutionary War. Included are General Washington's Headquarters Tent, a two-story replica of the Liberty Tree, **The Declaration's Journey** – a special exhibit celebrating the 250-year legacy of the Declaration of Independence – and more. Then get whisked back into the life of the 18th century working mother and upholsterer that is credited with making the first American flag at the **Betsy Ross House**. Relax with a stress-free dinner at another popular restaurant in Philadelphia.

DAY 5

Kickstart your morning with a delicious breakfast before departing for the **National Constitution Center**. Explore the country's most interactive history museum by taking in the story of "We the People" and walk among the life-size bronze statues in the **Signers' Hall** before taking the Oath of Office. Then enjoy an independent lunch and free time to explore **Independence National Historical Park** where you can visit historic buildings such as **Old City Hall, Congress Hall, Liberty Bell Center**, and more.

Later, you'll depart to Philadelphia's historic district and visit **Reading Terminal Market** where you can venture out and enjoy dinner on your own at one of the quirky and creative restaurants in the area.

End your day with **An Evening with a Founding Father** and hear a figure from America's past recount the story of the nation's founding and their part in history.

DAY 6

Pack your bags and enjoy breakfast before starting your journey home. Find a bite to eat before staying the night in Maumee, OH.

DAY 7

After one last breakfast and check out, you'll board the coach for the final leg home, carrying lasting memories of Historic Philadelphia and its celebration of the nation's **250th Birthday!**
